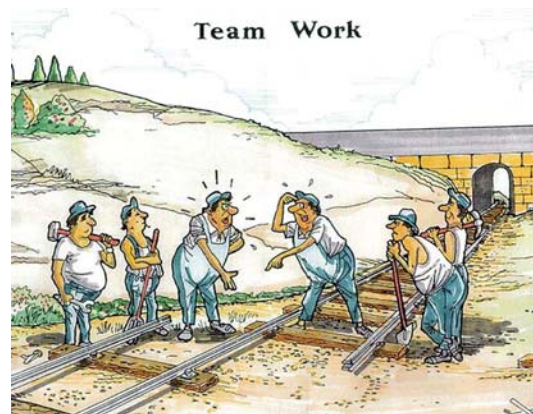
Space:

Events:

- Scavenger Hunt:

This is a high-energy team-building event that encourages teamwork while boosting morale, creating a spirit of adventure and at the same time using skills such as negotiation, planning, communication and time management. The group is divided into teams to perform a scavenger hunt searching for hidden clues to find the location of a product, lead, customer, or anything meaningful to the team. Each team will receive just a few clues; other clues will be hidden throughout the area and must be found or won in competitions to identify the final location. The West Point Scavenger Hunt*: **NEW**

This is an exciting and fun outdoor activity, a strong relationship-builder, stress reliever and an active way to explore the breath taking views of the Hudson River while at the same time learning the history of the Military Academy. Teams will be given a list of questions to be answered with a picture. The questions are in random order, challenging teams to determine their optimal route and to prioritize and complete the tasks in the allotted time. Each team selects a unique route, which means that teams can't follow each other around, however they frequently see each other along the way, adding to the competitive nature of the event. In addition, teams will be given parts of clues that are only meaningful when several clues are combined. Teams may negotiate a trade, compete for a clue or keep their clues thus preventing the other teams from winning. In Addition, each team will be given a survival bag that includes a camera, a map, snacks, waters and funny props to create funny pictures.

- The Power of ONE:

This is a highly interactive fun team activity designed to get participants to think outside of the box while using planning and communication skills to identify individual strengths. For recently formed teams or reorganized teams we suggest a Myers Briggs Type Inventory assessment prior to the event – A 20-30 minute online assessment that can be completed prior to the session. Teams will compete in activities where they must negotiate and choose the best member to lead the team in each activity. They will build towers out of common office supplies, build bridges made of spaghetti, play minefield games, perform in a “fear factor” activity, decipher riddles, etc...

This is a high impact experiential program integrating indoor training, exercises and feedback. This powerful combination of learning tools gives participants a strong sense of; the various effective leadership styles, the importance of **company culture and values, mentorship, accountability, trust, teamwork, community awareness and esprit de corp.** Under the direction of a retired Fire Chief, participants will learn about the work and the culture of the New York City Fire Department and then practice under simulated fire and rescue operations using the tools of the trade. This exercise will drive participants to crawl on the floor, communicate without words or visual senses, plan and revisit their own leadership style through the similarities and contrasts of an organization perceived to be very different than most.
